
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## DAY 35: DOUBTS OF FEAR

“But how are we going get her attention?” Senora can hear her own doubt with every word as she is almost spitting them out of her mouth through her chattering teeth.

Many times I have asked myself this same question. Is what I have to say of any importance? Will my words make a difference? If I rely on myself and my strength, then I could talk until I am blue in the face and it will never make a different. “And you were dead in the trespasses and sins, in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience-among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of great love which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ-by grace you have been saved-and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.”

Ephesians 2:1-9

Let's unpack what this verse is saying. To be dead in your trespasses and sins, what does this mean to you? How are you dead in your trespasses, how has God pulls out to freedom from sins control?

Grace means: an unmerited divine assistance given to humans for their regeneration or sanctification. Sanctification means: the state of growing in divine grace as a result of Christian commitment after baptism or conversion.
